### EXHIBITING ARTISTS

Shrine to be placed responsibly, where it will not impede traffic or people.

Shrine to be secured safely in place, with the owner's consent if attached to property.

Shrine to be in place (please inform us of the location) by 6pm Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> October - a map will be printed.

This is a public area, so all work is left at the artist's own risk.

All works to be removed Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> October, and the site left in the same condition as found.
